1. **Head of Department** - Serves as the Chairperson

3. **Periodic Review** - Conducts periodic (often annual) curriculum reviews for relevance and quality.
4. **Quality Assurance** - Oversees assessment standards, exam patterns, and evaluation processes.
5. **Meeting Frequency** - Typically meets at least once a year or as required to address curricular changes.
6. **Decision-Making Process** - Decisions are usually made by consensus or majority vote among the members.
