Bridge Course




- ■Conducted from the 2nd day onwards

SYLLABUS COVERAGE FOR STs & PUT

ST-I - First 2 units (40% syllabus completed)

ST-II – Next 2 units (60% syllabus completed)

PUT – All units (100% Syllabus completed)

Marks obtained in STs & PUTs carry significant weightage in internal assessment.

**Monday Tests – Every Monday, Class tests of one subject is conducted based on the syllabus covered in that subject in the previous weeks.



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ASSIGNMENTS

In each subject one assignment is given based on each unit. As there are 5 units in each subject, in total 5 assignments are given to the students.

Students need to submit the assignments timely as per given schedule.

Academic Discipline



- •Registration: In every semester, students will have to register on or before the last date of registration.
- •Lectures & labs: Students will have to attend all the theory & practical classes. Student has to take prior permission of class coordinator/HoD for any kind of leave.
- •Punctuality: Students have to come to class in time. Late entry in classroom/lab or early departure from classroom/lab etc. is strictly prohibited.





Academic Discipline

•Mobile phones and any other personal electronic gadgets must be switched off or in silent mode while in class or during any kind of curricular/co-curricular activity.

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Students are always required to carry with them their college ID-Cards.

Eatables, tea, coffee, soft drinks or other such items cannot be consumed during any class/lab.





ATTENDANCE

Attendance of each Class/Lab/Tutorial will be marked. As per AKTU norms, a minimum of 75% attendance is required to make students eligible to appear in End Semester University Examination. You should try to achieve 100% attendance.

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Our target is to achieve 90% average attendance in every class.

Attendance carries significant weightage in internal assessment.



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MANDATORY ATTENDANCE FOR SESSIONALS (STs) & PUT

The students will be detained if they have:

- Less than 75% attendance in ST-I.
- Less than 75% attendance in ST-II.
- Less than 75% attendance in PUT.
