

POLICY : WORK RELATED TO WEAK AND BRIGHT STUDENTS

All the course teachers are requested to ensure the compliance of following so as to improve the academic performance of weak and bright students of programs / courses / classes concerned :

1. Criteria for Identification of Weak Students / Slow Learners and Bright Students / Fast Learners

		Dept	Having NO Back Paper and SGPA > 8 in latest available Univ. End Sem Result (Sem / Session)	

NOTE :

- a. List of Weak and Bright Students may comprise of about 20-30% of total students (based on lowest / highest performance respectively (at entire 1 Year // Program, Branch and Sem level).
- b. Such list will be provided by respective HODs.
- c. Further, concerned faculty may add any student in the list, based on his / her feedback / class performance.
- d. Once, the list is finalized by respective course teacher, it remains same for the course / class throughout the semester.

2. Suggested Actions to be taken to improve the academic performance of Weak Students / Slow Learners

- a. Conduct of Revision / Doubt Clearing Classes
- b. Discussing basics and fundamentals of the subjects / courses concerned
- c. Solving difficult questions of University (AKTU) End Sem Question Papers
- d. Revising the taught contents (important ones, within 3-5 min either in starting or end of the lecture)
- e. Providing help for vocabulary of technical words
- f. Conducting Revision Tests
- g. Any other as decided by respective department / course teacher concerned



3. Suggested Actions to be taken to improve the academic performance of Bright Students / Fast Learners

- a. Asking to solve entire question bank
- b. Asking to solve difficult questions of University (AKTU) End Sem Question Papers
- c. Providing more practice questions
- d. Providing few questions of competitive examinations (e.g. GATE questions of courses concerned)
- e. Any other as decided by respective department / course teacher concerned

The criteria, quantity of weak / bright students and measures / actions to be taken (as mentioned above) may be updated by respective department. All the concerned are also requested to do all related record keeping.
